**NOTICE OF INTENTION TO DEVELOP THE PROVINCIAL SPATIAL DEVELOPMENT
FRAMEWORK FOR MPUMALANGA PROVINCE**

The Mpumalanga Department of Co-operative Governance and Traditional Affairs hereby gives notice, in terms of Chapter 4 Section 15 of the Spatial Planning and Land use Management Act of 2013 (SPLUMA), that it intends to develop the Provincial Spatial Development Framework to align with the provisions of SPLUMA. In keeping with the provisions of SPLUMA, the general public and all interested and affected parties are hereby notified of the department's intention to develop the Provincial Spatial Development Framework.

The process to be followed in developing the Provincial Spatial Development Framework is simplified below:

- Establishing the Project Management Committee (PMC) and the Project Steering Committee (PSC),
- Development of the Draft PSDF document by the PMC in consultation with the PSC and submission to Provincial Cabinet/Executive Council for a resolution to commence with public participation,
- Development of the final PSDF document by the PMC in consultation with the PSC after incorporation of comments received during public participation and submission to Cabinet/Executive Council for approval,
- Publish the approved PSDF in the media and Provincial Gazette.
